


State of Alaska Facts



- Juneau is the capital city of Alaska, and the second largest city of United States.
- > Alaska is the second-largest producer of oil in the United States.
- > Alaska is larger than Texas, California, and Montana combined.
- > Alaska is one of the leaders of seafood.
- ➤ Humpback whales migrate to Alaska during the summer.
- ➤ More American Indians live in Alaska than any other state.
- Alaska's state flower is the Forget-Me-Not.
- Alaska's state bird is the Willow Ptarmigan.
- > Alaska is known as the Last Frontier.
- ➤ The highest mountain in North American is located in Alaska, Mount Denali.
- Alaska and Hawaii are the only two states that is not bordered by another state.
- ➤ Alaska was hit with a tsunami in 1958 that measured 1,720 feet. The tsunami was taller than the empire State Building.
- According to the Alaska Earthquake Center, in 1964 a 9.2 earthquake hit Alaska and was so big it sloshed wells in Africa.
- ➤ Because of the long summer days, Alaskans are able to produce large vegetables. A cabbage was recorded at a weight of 127 pounds at the Alaska State Fair.
- Alaska is less than 50 miles from Russia.
- More than half of the world's glaciers can be found in Alaska.
- Most of America's salmon and crabs come from Alaska.
