- **Wells Super Club was the first to serve chicken and waffles together. It closed in 1982.**
- **Slaves from West Africa introduced battered, seasoned and fried chicken to America.**
- **Fried chicken was only served to wealthy whites prior to the Civil War.**
- **Slaves used Palm Oil to fry the chicken. Later it was fried in lard.**
- **Thomas Jefferson made waffles popular in America.**
- **The famous Roscoe's Chicken and Waffles is located in Los Angeles.**
- **President Obama visited in 2011, and ordered 3 wings and waffles.**
