

## BALD EAGLES FACTS

- IN 1782, THE BALD EAGLE WAS SELECTED AS THE NATIONAL SYMBOL.
- BALD EAGLES ONLY LIVE IN NORTH AMERICA.
- THE SILVER DOLLAR AND QUARTER HAS THE EAGLE ON IT.
- FEMALES ARE LARGER THAN MALES.
- BALD EAGLES HAVE A WING SPAN OF 5 8 FEET.
- THEY PREFER TO LIVE CLOSE TO RIVERS, PONDS AND OCEANS.
- THE LARGEST BALD EAGLES LIVE IN ALASKA.
- BALD EAGLES FOR ABOUT 20 30 YEARS.
- THEY BUILD THE LARGEST NEST OF ANY BIRD.
- THE LARGEST BALD EAGLE NEST WAS FOUND IN ST. PETERSBURG, FL. I WAS 9.5 FEET WIDE AND 20 FEET DEEP. IT WEIGHED 3 TONS.
- NEST BUILDING CAN TAKE UP TO 3 MONTHS.
- EGGS ARE AN OFF-WHITE COLOR.
- EAGLES ADD 1 FOOT OF NEW NESTING MARTERIAL TO THE WIDTH AND DEPTH OF ITS NEST EVERY YEAR.

- THE AVERAGE BALD EAGLE CLUTH IS 1 3 EGGS.
- THE EAST, BALD EAGLES START BUILDING THEIR NEST IN MID-FEBRUARY. EAGLES IN THE SOUTH STARTING BUILDING IN NOVEMBER.
- THERE ARE 2 TYPES OF EAGLES IN NORTH AMERICA, THE BALD AND GOLDEN EAGLES.



- BALD EAGLES CAN DIVE 100 MILES PER HOUR FROM THE AIR TO CATON PREY.
- EGGS ARE INCUBATED IN ABOUT 35 DAYS.
- THE SILVER DOLLAR AND QUARTER HAVE THE EAGLE ON IT.
- BALD EAGLE HAVE TALONS TO CAPTURE AND CARRY PREY.
- BALD EAGLES AREN'T REALLY BALD. THE WORD IS DERIVED FROM THE WORD "BALDE" MEANING WHITE.
- BABIES ARE READY TO LEAVE THE NEST IN ABOUT 35 DAYS.


